Emergency Food and Utility Bill Support Payment

50,000 yen will be distributed to households (one payment per household) exempt from resident taxes in 2022 and households with a sudden decrease in income in 2022. Those who are in households exclude from resident taxes must return the confirmation form by January 31st (postmarked). Those with a sudden decrease in income must apply to receive the payment. *Households supported by people who pay resident taxes and children excluded from resident taxes who are living alone are not eligible.

Deregistration and name change of motorcycles and light motor vehicles

♦ The light motor vehicle tax (tax rate by type) is levied on owners of motorcycles and light motor

vehicles on April 1 of each year.

♦ When a vehicle is disposed of or transferred to someone else with the license plates still attached, the owner will be taxed if they do not report the vehicle as scrapped or change the name of the vehicle.
